

## 2024 Gift Sunday

Gift Sunday, which will be held on December 7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup>, is a long-standing (40+ years) tradition here at St. Pius X. It helps to meet needs within our community as expressed by the agencies on this flier. The needs are as great as ever, they appreciate your generosity. You'll find a list of requested gifts sorted by agencies below.

If you purchase a gift, please do not wrap it. Please label it with the item name, size and age group, and indicate the designated agency (i.e. boy/girl 6+ years, 4T boy blue shirt and pants, woman's med black gloves). Gifts may be loose or in a box or bag.

Gift cards are strongly encouraged and may be purchased through St. Pius X's Scrip program or at a store, placed in an envelope(s) and labeled with the agency name. There will be a box for gift cards on the Altar and at the parish office. You may also use the included order form; which has space to write the name of the agency or agencies you would like the cards directed to.

## **Who are the organizations that receive the gifts from St Pius X?**

### **Eras Senior Network**

Eras Senior Network supports local Milwaukee and Waukesha seniors, adults with disabilities and family caregivers. The organization is excited to work with the community again to fill up to 400 self-sufficiency gifts for seniors and adults with disabilities living on a fixed low income. They will give at least \$50 in gift cards and postage stamps to each of the recipients to meet their most basic needs. Last year Eras served 1,939 individuals with 1,429 being in Milwaukee County!

St. Pius X supports Eras both financially and with volunteers. Keep an eye out for regular program offerings and updates in the Pius Press and the weekly bulletin.

### **La Causa Crisis Nursery & Prevention Program**

La Causa's Crisis Nursery and Respite Center is a 12-bed facility for sheltering children ages newborn to 12 years in times of family emergency/crisis or when a highly stressed parent needs respite care, a "time out" to prevent the possibility of child abuse and/or neglect. The bilingual staff provides a safe, nurturing and homelike environment for the children until the family situation is stabilized. Meanwhile, crisis management, support, information and referrals are provided to the parents. They are southeastern Wisconsin's only 24-hour Crisis Nursery, open 365 days a year.
