Eucharistic Minister

The Eucharistic Minister assists the celebrant in the distribution of the Eucharist .

Lector

The job of the lector is to prayerfully prepare the Scripture readings and then to proclaim them at Mass. The lector also reads the petitions and announcements.

Minister of Hospitality

The Minister of Hospitality's job is to greet people as they arrive, pass out hymnals/worship aids, answer questions and assist people as necessary. The minister of hospitality also enlists parishioners to take up the gifts, provides direction at communion time, distributes bulletins as people exit and checks the pews for hymnals, worship aids, etc. , at the end of Mass.

Acolyte

Acolytes prepare for the celebration of Mass (light candles, see that other materials needed for Mass are prepared), assist the celebrant as needed during Mass, and extinguish candles when Mass is over. This is a wonderful ministry open to children, young people, families and adults.

Worship Environment Minister

Worship environment ministers provide a tasteful liturgical environment for our celebrations. We are in need of anyone with any type of artistic talent, seamstresses, floral arrangers, and some workers willing to do some of the ladder climbing and heavier lifting.

Fellowship

Our Sunday experience continues with Fellowship in the cafeteria after our Sunday Masses. Fellowship workers help set up for Fellowship before the 8:00 Mass and clean up after the 10:30 Fellowship.

Celebration Singers

At this time this group is in a state of flux as it has no permanent director. It is open to adults and high school teens. For the time being, rehearsals will be held two Thursdays a month from 7:00 – 8:30 PM and the other two Thursdays from 1:00 PM to 2:30 PM. Prior to Christmas and Holy Week, rehearsals will be held weekly at 7:00 PM. The group sings 3 weekends a month (from September until May) at the 10:30 AM Sunday Mass. They also sing for the 10:00 PM Christmas Mass, the Holy Week liturgies and other special celebrations.

Jammin'for Jesus

Jammin' is a contemporary music group open to teens, young adults and young at heart. They provide musical leadership once a month at one of our weekend liturgies and are in need of singers and instrumentalists (keyboard, guitar, bass, drum, etc.). Rehearsals are usually held about twice a month on Monday evenings from 7– 8:30 PM. The group sings once a month from September through May generally at the 10:30 Sunday Mass

Cantors

Adults and high school teens are welcome to help provide music leadership for the assembly in this role. Rehearsals are held as needed and additional individual rehearsal time can be scheduled. Cantors are scheduled according to their availability. An audition is required for this ministry.

Resurrection Singers

This group provides musical support at funerals. This is a very flexible ministry – you sing whenever you are available.

Instrumentalists

Instrumentalists help to enhance the music at our liturgies and are invited to play for our weekend liturgies and for special seasonal celebrations. You will be scheduled to play according to your availability and rehearsals will be scheduled as necessary.
