The Trustee is a corporate officer with corporate and administrative duties. The Trustee is involved in the financial aspect of the parish. As an ex-officio member of the Pastoral Council, the Finance Council, and the Wauwatosa Catholic School Board, the Trustee is expected to attend these meetings. Trustees are the second signature on checks with the pastor. Candidates must be practicing Catholic parish members, at least twenty-five years of age, and need to be nominated in writing by ten or more parish members. **We are looking for one Trustee for a two-year term.** If more than one person is nominated, an election will be held after Masses the weekend of June 6/7.
